Volunteering is important to Northern Illinois University Athletics. It allows our studentathletes to give back and connect with the surrounding community. The dedication to community service extends throughout all 17 teams and 400+ student-athletes.



NIU student-athletes participated in more than 4,700 approved community service hours during the 2022-2023 school year, which included Habitat for Humanity, DeKalb Corn Classic, Soles4Souls, Operation Christmas Child Boxes and the Ronald McDonald House Charities among many others. This was an increase of over 2,200 hours from the 2021-22 year.

The 1899 Club, an approximately \$4 million multi-use facility that is the next step in fulfilling Northern Illinois University Athletics' commitment to provide enhanced nutritional services for NIU student-athletes in the form of a training table. Designed to build off of and expand on the Northwestern Medicine Sports Performance Center and the Phi Sigma Kappa Alumni Association of NIU Nutrition Center which opened in June 2019 and services all NIU student-athletes, the 1899 Club will initially provide training table meals for the NIU football, volleyball and basketball teams and will expand to additional programs. It will also be utilized for academic support services as well as provide for engagement opportunities.

#### **PRIORITY POINTS:**

Within each membership level, priority will be given based on total priority points. Priority Points are awarded based on the following calculations:

3 Points/\$100 donated to the Huskie Athletic Fund (Unrestricted)

1 Point/\$100 paid in Premium Seat License (PSL)

1 Point/\$100 donated to a sport/program specific fund

#### **SEASON TICKET LOYALTY BONUS:**

1 point awarded for each consecutive year as a season ticket member of Football, Men's Basketball, Women's Basketball, and Volleyball. \*Dating back to the 2005-2006 season. Max of 1pt/season

#### **ONE TIME BONUS ALLOCATIONS:**

10 points awarded to former Huskie student-athletes 5 points for NIU Alumnus

### **OTHER WAYS TO SUPPORT**

#### **ANNUAL FUND**

The HAF annual fund is at the core of our fundraising efforts for NIU Athletics. All monies raised through the annual fund (unrestricted gifts) directly support our mission of inspiring and sustaining excellence among our student-athletes in the classroom, in competition and in life. Specifically, the annual fund provides the Athletic Department operational flexibility. Your generous contributions to the annual fund provide us with the ability to address our most important priorities.

#### **COST OF ATTENDANCE**

Through cost of attendance our student-athletes receive additional resources (annual stipends of \$3,336 for full scholarship) above and beyond room, board, books, and tuition. These resources allow them to make the adjustment to life as a college student and supplement their reasonable living expenses, as the time demands of being a student-athlete inhibit their ability to have a job.

#### GIFTHN-KIND

This is a tremendous way for local and regional businesses or willing individuals to make a significant impact. Gift-in-kind is donated goods or services that would normally be purchased by NIU Athletics. Examples may include: food and beverage (i.e. team meals), housing, nutrition products, printing, and training facilities among other items.






